Paid positions are available for professional baristas with strong experience in coffee preparation in varying methods.

Ideal applicants must have the following skills and experience:

- Minimum 3 – 5 years experience working as a barista
- Experience working in specialty coffee
- Experience of competing in a state or national barista competition
- Have undertaken formal barista training
- Ability to stand for extended periods
- Ability to follow direction
- Good communication skills
- Ability to work well under pressure and to tight deadlines

Duties during the judging process will include preparing coffee exhibits for judging using a variety of methods, daily set up, calibration and maintenance of coffee machines, ensuring each exhibit is prepared to the highest standard and to judging specifications, and maintaining an extremely clean and tidy workspace.

Successful candidates will have the opportunity to meet some of Australia's leading coffee judges and top industry professionals and surround themselves with award winning products.

Baristas will have the opportunity to gain insight into the judging process and operation of a multifaceted roasted coffee competition.

The judging will take place in the Claremont Showground, home of the Perth Royal Food Awards, where an expert panel of judges will gather to assess entries. Gold, silver and bronze medals will be awarded, along with Champion trophies and the coveted Western Australian Coffee Grand Champion trophy.
